Highlights from over 250 years of protests

1776

- Demand: No taxation without representation
- Actions taken: Yale students dressed as teabags threw Native Americans into the Boston Harbor
- Result: American independence

1934

- Demand: Legalize intro Economics classes
- Actions taken: Get senators hooked on supply and demand curves
- Result: intro Economics classes legalized, black market renamed Economics Department

1961

- Demand: Improved student housing – one kitchenette, Jacuzzi, plastic ball pit, and bowling alley per suite
- Actions taken: Eighty day sit-down strike on Old Campus
- Result: Morse and Stiles built

2000

- Demand: Stop genocide
- Actions taken: Four candlelight vigils, picketing outside State Department
- Result: More genocide

2008

- Demand: Don't close Yale University
- Actions taken: Throwing stones at 242 Church Street, super-gluing oneself to the Women's Table
- Result: Closing of Yale University postponed until spring 2009
